## **DOL1 SCHOLARSHIP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR ACCREDITED HIGHER LEARNING GREEN BERET FOUNDATION**

**The following material includes information relating to the Green Beret Foundation Scholarship Program including eligibility and application requirements and a DOL1 scholarship application form.**

### **General Information:**

The Green Beret Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose mission is to answer the call of the Green Berets and their families so that they can succeed in their next mission.

Green Beret Foundation scholarship funds can be used for tuition, books, incidental fees, room and board, and other direct associated costs of higher education excluding transportation.

### **Purpose:**

To provide educational scholarships to deserving students within the Special Forces Community pursuing their undergraduate degrees.

### **Eligibility:**

**Applicants must be a child of a Special Forces Qualified Non-Commissioned Officer.** Children of Special Forces soldiers killed in action are otherwise covered and not eligible for this scholarship. The applicant must have been accepted by or already attending an accredited college, university, or vocational institution.

The following documentation is required for an application to be considered:

- DD 214 Form Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty and/or orders reflecting Special Forces Qualification of sponsor to be submitted with scholarship application,
- Most recent transcripts,
- SAT/ACT scores,
- Copy of accredited university's acceptance letter,
- Personal statement (500-1000 words) explaining need, use of scholarship and how your experiences or your family member's experiences in the Special Forces have affected you.
- Reference letter(s) from a teacher, counselor, and/or other evidence of scholastic achievement.

- One (1) page resume listing extracurricular activities, honors, employment, community service and/or special skills.
- A recent photograph suitable for publication; i.e., a cap and gown photo, or other professional quality and professionally dressed photograph to be published in the Foundation's newsletter and social media.

**A minimum 2.5 GPA is required.**

We prefer all communication be directly with you, the applicant, not a parent or third party. If all documents are not included in the original submission, then the application will not be considered.

All documents must be submitted electronically. Submission of documents via mail will **not be** considered.
